Artisans have been using the pristine white kaolin clay from Arita, Japan to make porcelain products for over 400 years. Kihara, based in Arita, honors that storied history and the porcelain's unblemished quality by employing traditional and innovative manufacturing processes to create porcelain pieces to suit modern tastes while respecting its design antecedents. Kihara's white porcelain acts as an unblemished canvas for the quiet but illustrative decorations adorning their wares. Baked at high temperatures, the pieces are thin but durable, a testament to the longevity of a honored Japanese art.

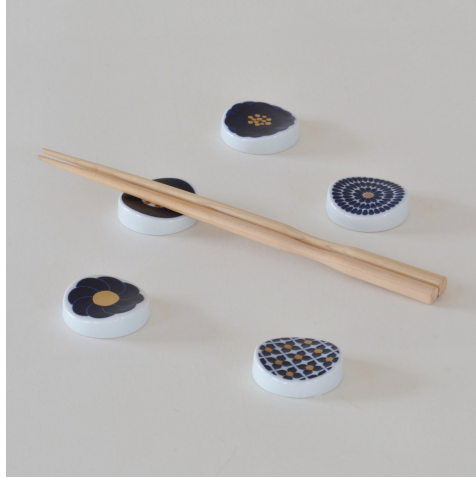
